VOLUNTEER OPPORTUNITIES

Kitchen

Serve meals to clients, staff, and visitors of the Mission.

Duties & Responsibilities

All volunteers are required to

- wash their hands prior to their shift
- wear gloves and an apron.
- hairnets are also required or you may bring your own hat to wear

Volunteers typically only serve meals. If you'd like to become involved with meal preparation, please consult with the Kitchen Supervisor. You'll be expected to become familiar with the kitchen first by serving meals.

Chapel or Music Ministry

Minister directly to the homeless and less fortunate, and help strengthen the hearts and minds of many. Be a speaker or share the gospel at one of our twice-daily chapel services.

Criteria

- Licensed or Ordained Pastor/Reverend with copy on file at GLM
- Seminary Student accompanied by pastor/reverend for first two chapel services and also recommendation letter on file with GLM from pastor/reverend
- Music Ministry with reference letter from church attending on file at GLM

Skills & Knowledge Required

- Strong Christian faith
- Experienced in worship leadership
- Strong knowledge of scripture
- Ability to work within the doctrinal guidelines of the Guiding Light Mission
- Reliable

Duties & Responsibilities

- Prepare your chapel message to fit into GLM's monthly chapel theme.
- Begin and end the service on time.
- Sing, play a musical instrument, or lead attendees in hymn as part of your service (optional).
- Allow time after your service for prayer.
- Ensure that your message does not conflict with the Guiding Light Mission statement of faith.

Time Commitment

Total service should be between 20 – 30 minutes. Going beyond 30 minutes delays food that has been prepared, volunteer time for service, etc.

Bible Study

Share your faith and knowledge of God's word by leading a Bible study for our START Program residents or for our Level 1 clients. This is a great opportunity for you to build and share your faith with others.

Man-2-Man Mentoring Program

Just one hour a week can impact a man's life forever. Mentors often encourage and demonstrate a positive example of how to live a fuller life through faith. This informal time with your mentee will be a blessing for you both.

Skills & Knowledge Required

- Christian faith
 - Reliability
 - Interpersonal communication skills
- Ability to follow up on mentee's progress
- Ability to communicate mentee's progress with Program Director

Duties & Responsibilities

- Meet with mentee once a week.
- Keep all scheduled meetings with mentee. Contact Program Director if scheduled meeting must change.
- Be a Godly role model, introduce mentee to other Christian men.
- Complete Mentor Progress Report after each mentoring session.
- Counsel from scripture.
- Encourage mentee to follow rules and complete the program.
- Pray for mentee daily.
- Help your mentee establish goals for his life.
